Leon and Lorraine Dillinger have been serving with Crossworld Missions, in Papua, Indonesia (West New Guinea) since 1958. They worked with the large stone-age West Dani tribe, learning their culture and language. In 1960 the West Dani tribe burned their evil spirit fetishes and turned to worship of the one true God. Their main ministries have included a three-year Bible Institute, discipleship, and writing Bible Commentaries. The Dillingers are career missionaries and are glad to share God's story in Papua with you. The pandemic has kept them from returning to Papua since 2019; however, they pray they will be able to return to Papua for future ministry.



The Ashcraft's

Lanny grew up as a missionary kid in Monterrey, Mexico and returned there after Seminary and marriage to Pam, in 1971. With their family they served in Monterrey and Chihuahua for over 30 years, focusing on a children's home, evangelism and planting and pastoring La Fe Baptist Church.

They currently live in Joshua, Texas and are actively retired, remaining active in their home church Joshua Baptist, and encouraging churches, pastors and outreach ministries in Mexico, Guatemala and several other Central American Countries. Lanny and Pam have been partnering with Spicewood Baptist Church and Impact Guatemala for the past 3 years.
